General Points:

Opioids should be avoided for the treatment of migraine.

If you suspect medication overuse, basic patient education and an attempt of withdrawal must be tried prior to neurology referral.

When to Submit a New Referral

If the patient develops red flag headache features or, the patient fails at least 3 preventative treatment trials.

If the patient's clinical status changes and requires neurological consultation, please submit a new referral to Neurology Central Access and Triage.
